I look forward to seeing you on December 8th.

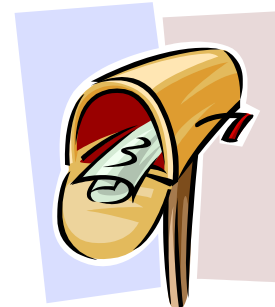

The City of Des Moines is very interested in making some improvements to the south end of the city and they have three projects in mind: A soccer field at Woodmont Elementary, a playground area, and a trail that would provide pedestrian access between Marine View Drive South in the Redondo area and Marine View Drive South in the Woodmont area. This is a great way to get involved in our community in a way that could enhance our area. Volunteer help would be needed to assist with these projects, as money is very tight now due to I-695 cuts. However, the city also recognizes that they have not spent money on enhancements to our end of the city since it was annexed. The trail, specifically, could easily tie in with Woodmont trails and open up and enhance a larger area for pedestrian access. FROM THE OCTOBER ISSUE OF Des Moines City Currents

- On September 11, the Des Moines City Council voted to repeal the City's new Street Light Utility due to concerns expressed by the community.
- Sea-Tac's 3rd Runway suffered another setback when Port of Seattle was unable to meet federal and state deadlines for a wetlands permit. This means they will have to file an unprecedented third time to obtain the permit. The Airport Communities Coalition will continue to hold the Port accountable for our neighborhoods.
- The City of Des Moines and SeaTac Disposal will provide free Holiday Tree recycling for single family residents on regular collection days of January 12, 13 and 14. There will be more information in the January *Currents* edition.
