UPCOMING PROJECTS: The following projects are anticipated or currently in the works:

Tennis Courts—this has been identified as a top priority by the board for this year. A committee of five, has been formed and is charged with researching and presenting a proposal for a multi-use facility at our March 2006 meeting or sooner. Gary Spies is serving as the chair of this committee.

Plaza Railing—the Long Range Planning Committee is preparing a plan for a railing to extend along the bulkhead at the plaza. Bill Kennedy is the chair for this committee.

Earthen Steps at Northbeach—the trail that heads up towards the staircase behind Northbeach is deteriorated. We plan to construct steps similar to those constructed on the Dog Trail sometime this summer. Larry Allen heads up maintenance for the club. Volunteers may be solicited.

Picnic Tables—our picnic tables at the plaza could use some attention. They may need to be power washed and/or stained again this year. Contact Larry Allen if you would like to help with this.

Signage—the board is looking into improving and adding signage on our club property. This includes "No Dumping" and "No Trespassing" signs, as well as signs to designate club trails and spaces.

SEWER CONSTRUCTION



Recently, we were contacted by Mid-Mountain Contractors of work that will be done on the sewer line along the beach in our club. This is a continuation of work that was done last summer south of the club boundaries. Work is scheduled to begin August 15 and must be completed by September 30. Most equipment and materials will be transported daily by barge and all excavated areas will be covered up at the end of each shift. The impacted area will extend 1500 feet from the plaza to beyond our club boundaries to the south.
