Special Assessment Passes

At the May 24 General Membership Meeting, the membership voted to approve a one-time special assessment. the assessment is in the amount of \$100 for members and \$75 for seniors. This assessment is in addition to the regular annual dues and is required for membership. The assessment will provide funds for the following projects:

New plaza picnic tables

We will purchase 6-10 new picnic tables to replace the worn-out picnic tables at the plaza. These new tables have steel tubular frames and "weather-proof" surfaces of a resign-type material. The tables fold for easy storage or transport, and are adjustable in height.

Railing at Plaza

It has been discussed for some time now to install a railing for safety at the plaza. A new railing will be installed along the west and south sides. The railing will be 42 inches high with a black powder coated finish and will run between 4 or 5 new brick columns to match the existing columns.

Lookout on Bootlegger Trail

Tim Clemmans, a member of our community and an Eagle Scout candidate plans to build a platform over the bluff on the Bootlegger Trail, just north of the connecting trail to S. 265th Street. Up to \$1000 from the assessment will fund this project.

Improved Electrical Service

During club events at the plaza, we routinely have problems with our electrical service with the breakers often popping. We plan to have an electrician inspect our panel and assess whether it needs to be upgraded. If he recommends an upgrade and funds from the assessment are still available, this work will be done.
